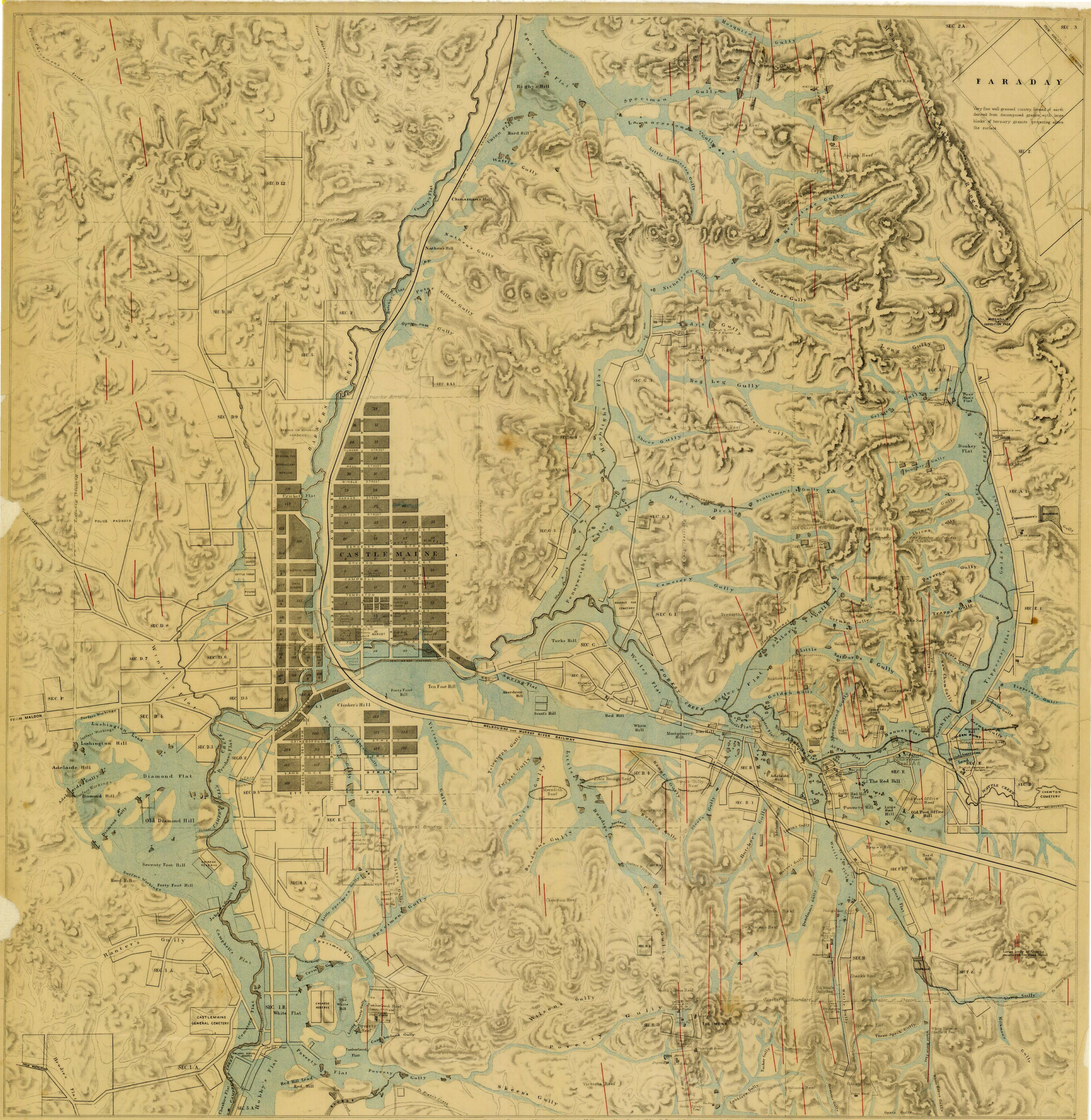


# FARADAY
