Situate to the east of the Coliban river, and in the parish of Metcalfe and county Dalhousie; being also in the FRYERS-CREEK DIVISION of the CASTLEMAINE DISTRICT

The gold-workings are shown by the alluvial diggings being colored blue, and the quartz-reefs red. Those parts colored pink denote the 'privileges' which have been granted to mining parties.
