SHEWING SURFACE EXTENSIONS OF QUARTZ REEFS NORTHWARD FROM EAGLEHAWK, SANDHURST

NOTE.—In addition to the cleared lines along the supposed course of the reefs, the main surveyed line from Lightning Hill northerly, and the lines East and West, as shown on the plan, have been cleared and marked by stations about a quarter of a mile apart, for the determination of parties engaged in exploring the reefs.
