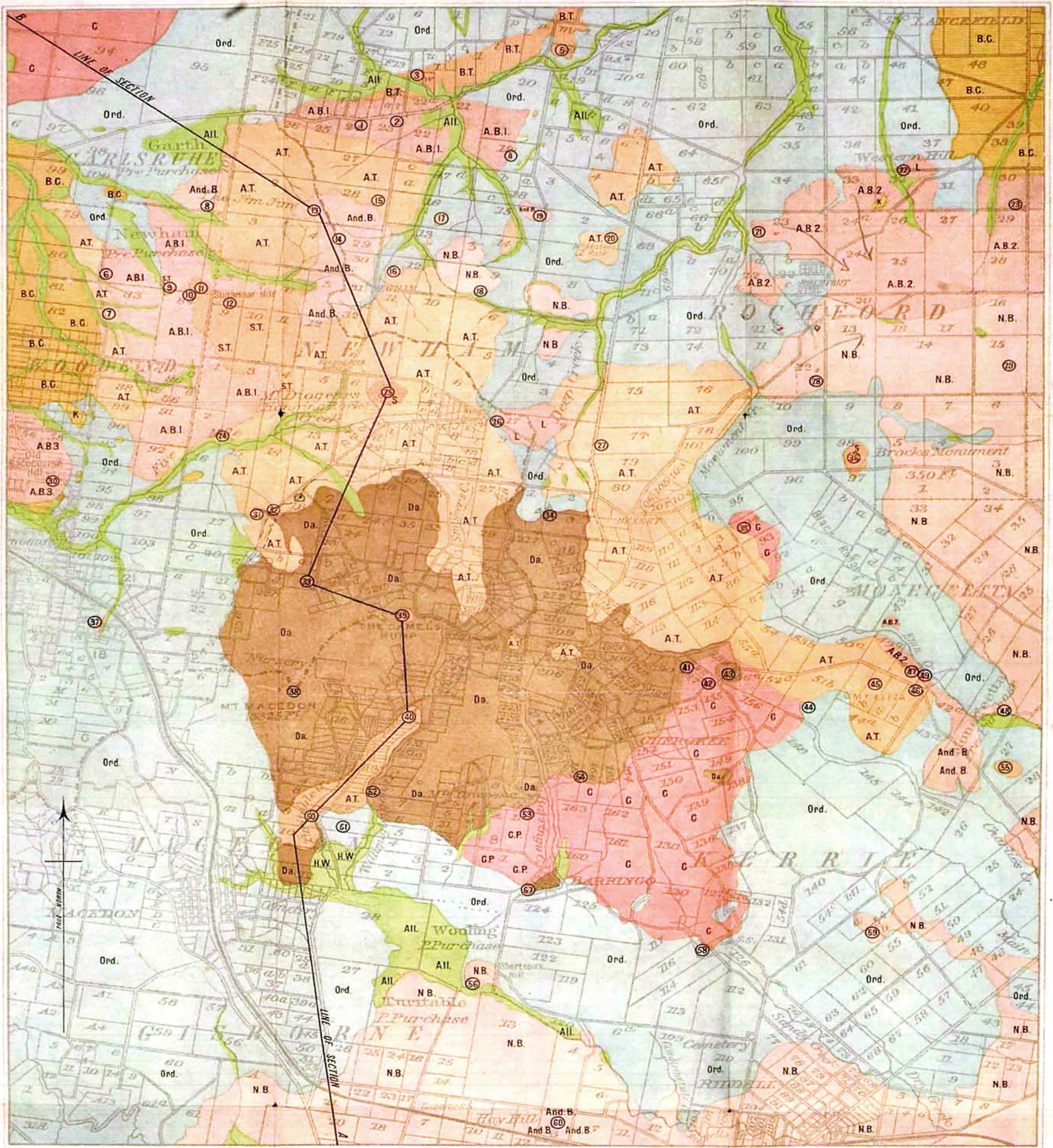


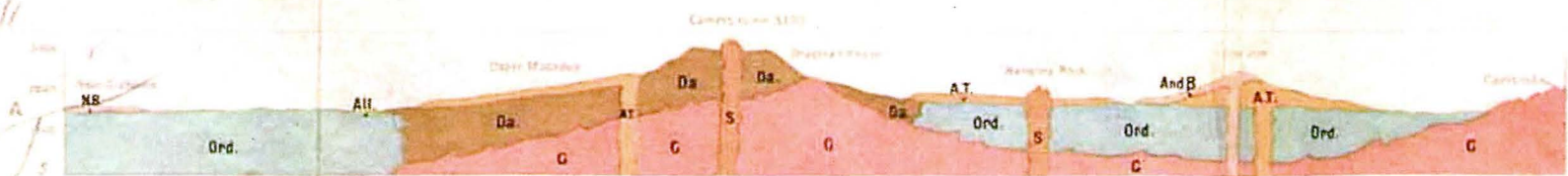
# GEOLOGICAL MAP OF THE MACEDON DISTRICT
