- Recent, (Alluvial flats & hill tatus)
- Post Pliocene, (Terraces of gravels, sands & clays)
- Lower Devonian?, (Dense fragmental porphyry)
- Metamorphosed Upper Ordovician, (Schists & indurated sandstone)
- Granite, (Grey) & Quartz reefs
- \searrow Dip & strike of strata
- \sim 2500' Aneroid heights above sea level
- \sim -1000' -500' Approximate contours
