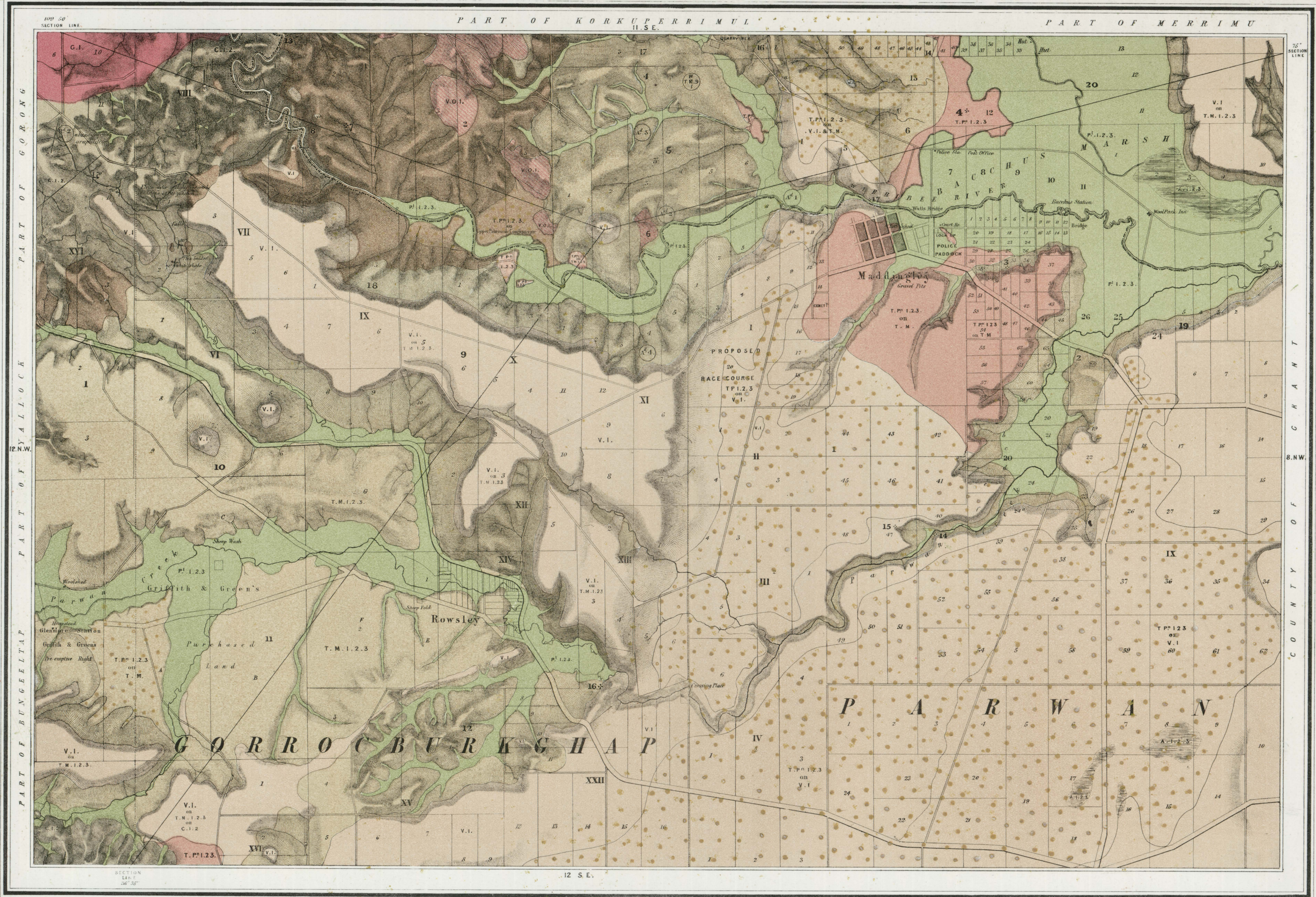

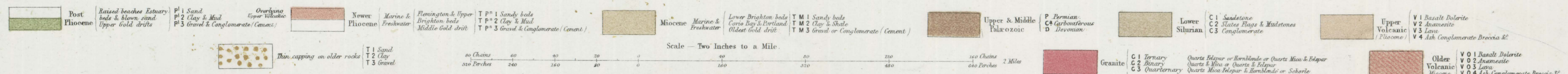
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Deposits of sand, clay & gravel of the age of the upper Gold drifts, 'Alluvial' or Post Pliocene occur at intervals along the courses of all the valleys. These deposits are frequently cut through & redistributed by cutting rivers, when during floods, forming alluvial A. 1.2.3. Recent Gold drifts.
