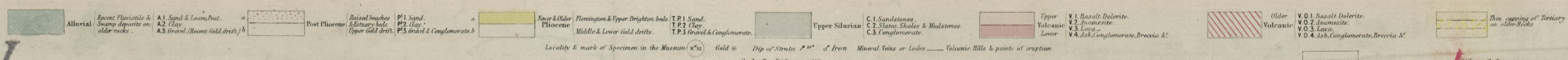

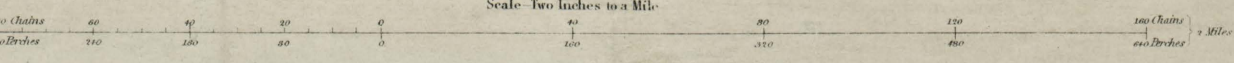
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Deposits of sand, clay & gravel of the age of the upper drifts. Divalent or Post Pliocene occur at intervals along the course of all the valleys. These deposits are irregularly cut through & redistributed by existing river action during flow.

Scale: Two inches to a Mile. Dip of Strata 10° & Iron Mineral Veins or Lodes Volcanic Hills & points of eruption Limestone L.I. Tertiary
